### ★ ABOUT *US*

Missouri Family Health Council, Inc. is a private nonprofit that champions access for every individual to culturally sensitive, quality, sexual and reproductive health education and services. MFHC is the federal grantee for the Missouri Title X program.

#### What is Title X?

Established in 1970, Title X (ten) is a federal program dedicated to providing family planning services. Title X primarily serves lower-income populations with low- to no-cost, confidential family planning services.

#### What Services are Included in Title X?

Contraception counseling & supplies; well-woman and men exams; clinical breast and cervical cancer screenings; STI & HIV prevention, testing, and treatment; pregnancy testing & counseling; preconception care; reproductive life planning.

55,952 STI & HIV tests



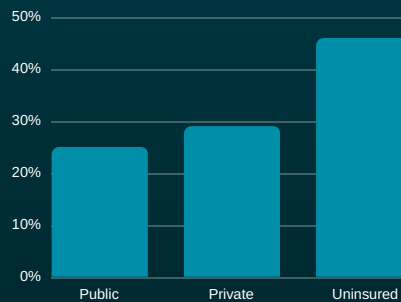
### ✔ WHO *we* SERVE



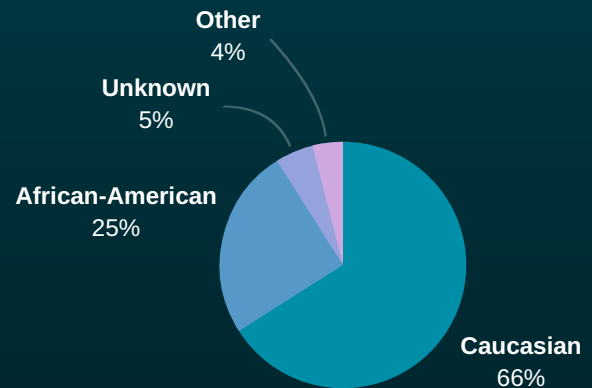
23% of clients are under age 20.
