
## WHAT'S TITLE X?

Established in 1970, Title X (ten) is the nation's first and only federal program dedicated to providing family planning services. Title X primarily serves lower-income populations with low- to no-cost, confidential family planning services. Missouri Family Health Council is the state's sole Title X grantee.

## TITLE X SERVICES:

Contraception counseling and supplies; well-woman and men exams: clinical breast and cervical cancer screenings; STI and HIV prevention, testing, and treatment; pregnancy testing and counseling; preconception care; reproductive life planning; and basic infertility services.


