After seven years of dedicated leadership, the executive director for Missouri Family Health Council, Inc. (MFHC), Connie J. Cunningham, has announced her resignation. Starting April 1, she will assume the role of executive director of the St. Louis County's Children's Service Fund.

Some of the many accomplishments Ms. Cunningham achieved during her seven-year tenure include: strengthening the Missouri Title X Network; increasing MFHC's scope of services to include an incarcerated women's family planning program and a three-year HPV prevention program; implementing the 2014 updated Quality Family Planning Guidelines; and facilitating new relationships with statewide and national organizations.

MFHC's Board of Directors will actively manage the organization's executive transition. An ad hoc Transition Committee has been put into place to facilitate the placement of an interim executive director and will direct a search for permanent leadership. MFHC staff is committed to assisting the Board of Directors in a smooth transition and assuring no gaps in service to the Missouri Title X Network.

"I was offered an opportunity that I won't get again - the next big step for me. MFHC is in good hands. There is a lot of support for this agency and people are supporting the work now and in the years to come."
