## **KATY TRAIL NEWEST ADDITION TO MISSOURI TITLE X NETWORK**

Missouri Family Health Council announces its nineteenth agency to join to the Title X Network, Katy Trail Community Health. Katy Trail will provide family planning services at three clinic sites in the Sedalia area.

MFHC's mission is to support access to quality reproductive health care services through funding, education, monitoring and advocacy. MFHC is the federal Title X grantee for the state. Title X was enacted, federally, in 1970 and the program serves men, women and teens at little or no cost. The Title X program supports a broad range of FDA-approved contraceptive methods and related counseling; as well as breast and cervical cancer screening; pregnancy testing and counseling; screening and treatment for sexually transmitted infections (STIs); HIV testing; and other patient education and referrals.

Missouri Family Health Council issued the following statement in response to the new grantee, attributed to Executive Director, Connie J. Cunningham:

“MFHC is very pleased to add this quality health center to the family planning network in Missouri. Katy Trail will fill a large gap in services for women, men and teens in Sedalia, Warsaw, Versailles and the surrounding areas. Increasing access to reproductive health services is our passion and we are excited to expand our reach and serve more families.”
